CONNECTICUT OPEN ANNEXED BY CIUCI

Mill River Pro Scores 152 to Win First Annual Tourney Over Yale Links.

NEW HAVEN, Conn., Aug. 24 (P).—Henry Ciuci, professional at the Mill River Country Club in Stratford, today shot a 152 over the difficult Yale golf course to win the first annual Connecticut open tournament, sponsored by the Connecticut Golf Association.

Ciuci led a field of eighty players. A light rain fell during the early play, while heavy clouds prevailed all day, and a strong, chilly wind swept the course.

Jack Ryan, assistant professional at the Yale course, shot a 154 for second, while Charles Clare, Race Brook Country Club, recent winner of the State amateur championship, tied with Gene Kunes of Tumble Brook, Bloomfield, and Andrew Ponsi of Round Hill, Greenwich, for third, with 155 each.

Ciuci won the \$250 first prize as well as the Golf Association shield to be held by his club for a year. Ryan received \$130 while Kunes and Ponsi shared the \$95 total prizes for fourth and fifth.

Clare, as the amateur winner, received a silver plate.
